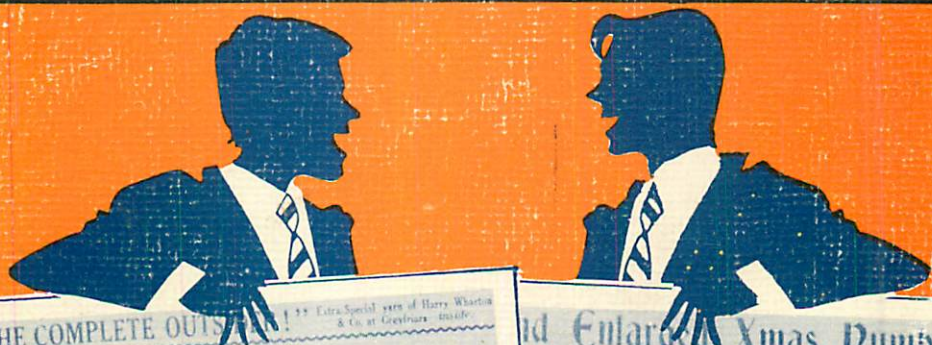

The writing phenomenon known to the world as Frank Richards (real name Charles Harold St. John Hamilton) died at his home at Kingsgate, near Broadstairs in Kent on Christmas Eve, 1961. By that time it is estimated that he had written the equivalent of one thousand full-length novels. But although his stories had been loved for thirty years and more before the outbreak of the Second World War, it was not until the last twenty years of his life that he himself became well known and eventually had an entry in *Who's Who*. When he died there was a half column obituary in *The Times* and reports in all the other national newspapers. He had become a legend.

Born at Oak Street, Ealing, Middlesex on August 8th 1876, Charles Hamilton was the sixth in a family of five brothers and three sisters. His father, John Hamilton, was a master carpenter and one-time stationer, his grandfather a landscape gardener; and the family can be traced back to 1771, when a great-grandfather owned houses and The Black Horse Inn in Berkshire. Charles, who was a keen reader from an early age, was educated privately and also attended a Private School for Young Gentlemen—Thorne House School, in Ealing.

He wrote his first story in 1885. His early work is to be found mainly in The Trapps Holmes boys' papers and comics, and his output was prodigious. At one time he was writing at least six stories and serials every week, under about twenty different pen-names. Apart from school stories he wrote adventure, romance, travel, crime, humour and serious works.

In the autumn of 1906 he wrote his first stories of St. Jim's, in *Pluck*, and these were followed by the appearance in the new *Gem* in 1907 of Tom Merry & Co. In 1908 the best-loved and best-known school of all time—Greyfriars—appeared in *The Magnet*, detailing the adventures of Harry Wharton & Co. and—perhaps the most famous of all his characters, Billy Bunter, the Fat Owl of the Remove. *The Magnet* was to entrance generations of readers from 1908 to 1940.

In 1910 he created a new school in the Empire Library (featuring Gordon Gay & Co), whilst in 1915 the Rookwood stories of Jimmy Silver & Co. commenced in the *Boys' Friend*, later to be featured in the *Popular*. In 1919 he introduced yet another school – Cliff House – for the *School Friend*, which was to delight millions of girl readers; although to be factually accurate, he had introduced Cliff House in his Greyfriars stories many years previously. Whilst school stories were his favourite theme, he also created The Rio Kid, a Western outlaw, for the *Popular*, a South Seas Series, 'Ken King of the Islands' for *Modern Boy* and, for the same paper, Len Lex, the Schoolboy Detective; in addition to an unusual series called The School for Slackers. All this as well as his contribution to the yearly Holiday Annuals.

Frank Richards was a kindly, easy-going, impractical man who wrote because he enjoyed writing; the acquirement of money was a secondary consideration. He wrote with ease and as a consequence he was easily readable. As a further consequence, money came easily, and he spent it with equal ease, not bothering about the future but living only for the present.

In his stories he deplored gambling in any form; he made it quite clear that betting was 'a mug's game'. No keen reader of his narratives could have any illusions on that score. Yet Frank Richards himself appears to have been an inveterate gambler. When he was a young man his money went on the tables of the gaming houses on the Continent; later, the money he earned from his writing was carried away by slow horses. He put nothing by for the rainy day – in fact, it never occurred to him that there would be a rainy day.

World War II unhappily saw the end of *The Magnet* and, indeed, nearly all the juvenile papers. It seemed that Charles Hamilton's works were destined to disappear into obscurity, but with the publication of the Bunter Books by Charles Skilton and, subsequently by Cassells, the issuing of the Tom Merry Annuals and the B.B.C. television series featuring Greyfriars and the ubiquitous Bunter, not to mention Christmas plays at the Victoria Palace, London, his characters suddenly acquired a fresh lease of life and brought Hamilton a deserved recognition and a renewed popularity.

Billy Bunter on television gained this plump character millions more admirers. After auditioning a very large number of artists, the B.B.C. found the perfect Bunter in actor Gerald Campion. Campion was a triumph in a role which many people thought could never be played successfully. Hamilton wrote the scripts for all the television plays, and Gerald Campion's acting added a new dimension to the character of the Owl of the Remove.

Hamilton's autobiography, published in 1952 and reprinted in 1962,

was eagerly bought by his admirers and although it was in the main somewhat disappointing, it did reveal many interesting facts not only about the author but about his creations. At the height of his career he was writing a million and a half words a year, and they were written in Britain, Rome, Venice, Nice, Monte Carlo, Munich and other Continental cities. His foreign reminiscences included descending into the crater of Vesuvius and hanging on to the outside of the Monte Carlo express!

It has been an almost impossible task to record all his work, but to date the compilers of his biography have discovered more than one hundred schools which he created, with a total of at least five thousand stories. So popular were they that well over three thousand were reprinted in various other publications. Almost 75% of the Schoolboys Own Library consisted of reprints of his works, and it is estimated that he penned a hundred million words during his lifetime.

In the last twelve years or so of his life, Hamilton turned again to one of the subjects which had dominated his own schooldays. Latin does not normally stand high on the list of a schoolboy's 'likes'; it is a stern and uncompromising language, and its literature is deficient in jokes.

Hamilton, however, had a love for Latin and a proficiency in the use of it. He also felt that the average schoolboy would have the same liking and proficiency if its literature could be made more attractive. After all, we had recently seen the publication of *Pinoculus* in Italy and *Winni-ille-Pu* in this country; why not *Bunteri Stultitia*? One instalment of it appeared in the Latin newspaper *Acta Diurna*, and others would no doubt have followed if Hamilton had lived longer. During 1961 he wrote a Bunter story in Latin which was published in *The Times Educational Supplement*.

His school stories were, however, always written in impeccable English, which is probably the reason why so many readers continued to absorb Greyfriars and St. Jim's long after boyhood was left far behind. Frequent references to classic literature were noteworthy factors in his school tales.

In his last years Charles Hamilton suffered not only from ill-health but from the greatest handicap that can befall a writer — failing eyesight. Despite this he never failed to answer the letters which continued to arrive from old and new readers, from all over the world.

On Christmas Eve 1961, the radio and TV gave the news of his death. Probably he received more coverage than any other writer of boys' fiction, and there were many who mourned the loss of 'Frank Richards', 'Martin Clifford' and 'Owen Conquest'. But although Hamilton himself had died, his brilliant character studies of boys and masters ensured his immortality.

Apart from the boys of Greyfriars — Harry Wharton and Co., Horace Coker, Vernon Smith the 'Bounder', Loder, Wingate, not to mention Billy Bunter, there was the unforgettable Mr. Quelch, the Remove form-master, The Reverend Dr Locke, William Gosling, the school porter, Paul Pontifex

Prout, and a host of others. All these, and many more, can be found within the pages of his books.

Without any question he had a profound influence for good on the youth of Britain during the first forty years of this century. He taught a splendid moral code, without the slightest suggestion of preaching or priggishness; a sensitive, gentle, scholarly man, who asked little and gave much. A character, too, in later years, with his black skull cap, his shawl, pipe and corduroy trousers with bicycle clips to keep out the draught. Withal a charming gentleman whose standards of moral decency and professional workmanship are regrettably conspicuous by being so unusual in the world in which he lived at the end.

Although the post-war years brought the return of Greyfriars stories in other formats, nothing quite recaptured the evergreen magic of the original paper until Howard Baker presented the first of his now world-renowned faithful facsimiles. Each of these editions contains a complete series of stories from *The Magnet's* Golden Years. And each is a faithful fitting memorial to the glowing imagination, the humour and the humanity, the well-nigh incredible industry of its brilliant author.

'Frank Richards' loved writing for the young and affirmed that no writer could do any better work in life than this. Certainly none did it better than Frank Richards himself.

The MAGNET

In one sense the Magnet was the brainchild of an Amalgamated Press Editor, Percy Griffith, who thereupon became this new paper's first editor, too. In another sense it might be said that if it truly had any human father that man was Charles Hamilton who, as a direct result of its birth, was going to be better known for the rest of his life as Frank Richards.

If magazines had to have birth certificates the precise parentage of this one might be long debated. But, in the end, it is likely that the exact truth would be stated, incomplete as it is, and that in the appropriate place on the form would be written succinctly 'Magnet, son of Gem'.

Percy Griffith had launched this other, earlier paper on March 16th 1907 with only the vaguest idea of what its grown shape would actually be, and as is the case with so many children the toddling, tottering infant didn't much resemble the eventual man. It carried adventure stories from a prolixity of pens alternately with fortnightly school stories from one 'Martin Clifford'. In brief, it had a confused childhood, but it grew up fast.

Eleven months later the adventure stories, as such, were gone for good, and Griffith knew precisely what sort of a paper the Gem would be for the rest of its life: a good paper and a school-story paper. And he knew more. Readers were clamouring for another paper like it. Not one identical with it, but one evolved from it.

Son of Gem, thy name is Magnet: an irresistible and enduring force of attraction. Who can deny sixty-six long years later that the name was most apt? And so, on February 15th 1908, the Magnet was born.

Percy Griffith, the man, the first editor, remains much of a mystery. We are not certain of the date or the place of his death; we don't even know when, or where, he was born. Hardly anyone now alive remembers him, and the few people who do are most reluctant to talk. All that anyone can, or will, say is that he was a bohemian type and a great talker; lively, quick-witted and energetic.

The reader could probably glean all that is known of him from Frank Richards' Autobiography, particularly when armed with the knowledge that Griffith was the 'V.C.' Richards also referred to.

Griffith was assisted in the Magnet and Gem office by Herbert Allan Hinton, his second-in-command, and by a sub-editor, Charles Maurice Down. The office boy was R. T. Eves, who in later years founded the School Friend, and eventually joined the Board of Amalgamated Press as a director.

Meantime, in 1911, Percy Griffith suddenly, and hurriedly, left Fleetway House for an unknown overseas destination, and that was the last anyone saw of him. It is now presumed that he is long dead. Nick-

named 'Pushful Percy' for his ability to get things done and squeeze the utmost out of his authors there is little doubt that his wild streak of bohemian improvidence, touched on by Richards in his Autobiography, ruined what would otherwise have been a most remarkable career in the realm of boys' fiction.

Certainly much credit is due to him for creating the most famous boys' paper in history.

Following Griffith's dramatic exit, his second-in-command Herbert Allan Hinton took over: a man whose temperament contrasted completely with that of his predecessor in every respect. Born in 1880, Hinton had been educated at a public school, and was distantly related to Alfred Harmsworth, the founder of The Amalgamated Press. Nicknamed 'Trooper' because of his connection with the Kent Yeomanry, he was a man of magnificent physique and much addicted to black cigars. This despite his moralistic preaching on the evils of smoking in his companion paper *The Boys' Friend*.

Frank Richards always claimed that George Figgins of *St. Jim's* was modelled on Hinton, but this has been disputed. According to a sub-editor who knew him well, the character who bore most resemblance to Hinton was Larry Lascelles, the games master at Greyfriars.

1914 came, and the beginning of the first world war, and almost immediately the *Companion Papers'* staff in Fleetway House was decimated as, one after another in rapid succession, sub-editors 'answered their Country's call' and volunteered for war service. C. M. Down – by this time chief sub-editor – was the first to go. He took a commission in August 1914, and was closely followed by Hedley O'Mant, Noel Wood-Smith, W.E. Stanton Hope, W. E. Pike, G. R. Samways and H. W. Twyman, who was later to become editor of the *Union Jack*.

Surprisingly, H. A. Hinton did not go until 1916, when he joined the Coldstream Guards with the rank of Captain. Meanwhile, in his editorials, he made great play of receiving flocks of white feathers from readers, all intimating that he was a coward. Coward he was certainly not; astute editor he equally certainly was. The white feathers were wholly imaginary, conjured up to inject some controversy into his columns, and at the same time to do something towards linking the fiction of Greyfriars with the cold, cruel outside world of implacable fact.

After 1916, its office denuded of staff, a writer was hurriedly called in to steer the paper through the rest of the war, and the man appointed was probably the most controversial editor of all. John Nix Pentelow, this third editor of the *Magnet*, was born at St. Ives, Huntingdon, in 1872, his father being the local grocer. He had begun writing at an early age, having his first story published when he was only fifteen, and he had rapidly become both versatile and prolific. School stories, sports stories and adventure stories all flowed from his pen.

Although only forty-four years of age when he became editor of the *Magnet* and the *Gem* in 1916, he looked at least twenty years older. Business worries had prematurely aged him, and his hair was white, his

shoulders bowed. He was also very deaf and as he scorned the use of a hearing aid a quiet conversation with him usually ended up jarring the windows throughout Fleetway House.

For all that he was a kindly man, and many writers of repute today speak highly of the help he gave them in their early years. Probably the greatest criticism aimed at his editorship was that he himself wrote a disproportionate number of the Greyfriars and St. Jim's stories published during the last two years of the war, though it is difficult to see what else he could have done with no material coming from Charles Hamilton, and nearly all the substitute writers away on active service.

With the end of the war and the return of the former staff, Herbert Allan Hinton resumed the editorship of the Companion Papers, and John Nix Pentelow moved on to become editor of the Boys' Realm and Sport and Adventure, together with several smaller libraries. Eventually retiring from the staff of the Amalgamated Press in 1923, Pentelow died at Carshalton in Surrey in 1931, at the age of fifty-nine.

Meantime, Hinton's second occupancy of the editor's chair did not last for long. Like Percy Griffith before him he had acquired somewhat expensive tastes, and in 1921 he was caught out in the plagiarism of a Greyfriars story, which led him to leave Fleetway House somewhat abruptly. Thereafter he founded his own boys' paper, entitled School and Sport, and at the outbreak of the second world war was editing Dalton's Weekly.

Six years later, whilst in a train near Weybridge Station on New Years' Day, 1945, during the blackout, Hinton opened the door of the carriage furthest away from the platform and fell to his death. He was widely mourned. Despite his failings, he was a jovial, friendly man, and one whom one could not help liking.

The fourth, and last, editor of the Magnet was Charles Maurice Down, a tall, distinguished, military-looking man, and one who had been on the staff of the Companion Papers from the very first issues of the Gem and the Magnet. He was, as a result, quite the most experienced editor the paper ever had, and also quite easily the most successful.

Son of a Justice-of-the-Peace, he had had a public school education, and was a gentleman in every sense of the word.

Charles Hamilton made no secret of the fact that he based one of his most universally popular characters on him, that of D'Arcy – better known as 'Gussy' – the Swell of St. Jim's, and for anyone who has ever had the privilege of meeting him it is easy to see why. Though it should be stated that Mr. Down does not speak with a lisp!

Probably his greatest single contribution to the Greyfriars saga was made when he conceived the idea of producing the Holiday Annual, which was not only the most popular annual of all in its time, but remains easily the one most sought-after by collectors today – evidence the fact that copies change hands at considerably more than the original price.

THE SCHOOLBOYS' OWN LIBRARY

The Schoolboys' Own Library was the brain-child of C. M. Down the Magnet editor, who had in 1920 also devised the idea of the Holiday Annual. A tremendous money-spinner from the start, it involved the Amalgamated Press in the minimum of production costs, since nearly all the stories were reprints from school serials that had appeared earlier in the Magnet, Gem, Boys' Friend or Nelson Lee Library and which had already been paid for. The authors – the main one being Charles Hamilton – were paid an honorarium of five guineas for every issue published. The editor making the selection, cutting, and revision was likewise paid the same sum, as a bonus. Last, and certainly not the least, the reader was able to buy, for the low sum of fourpence, a full book length yarn of his favourite school, mainly the cream of serial stories that had appeared long before he became a reader.

The monthly appearance of these neat, pocket-size volumes with their trade mark of a blue edge around the front cover illustration, was also far easier to slip into the pocket. Even better still, they could be read surreptitiously behind a school desk or in a church pew during an overlong sermon. The sales of this highly successful venture exceeded 50,000 a month, and were on a par with the Boys' Friend and Sexton Blake Libraries.

In the mainly Hamilton contributions, if ever proof was needed that Greyfriars was far higher in popularity to St. Jim's or Rookwood it can be gauged from the fact that tales of Greyfriars consisted of 184 issues, St. Jim's 81, and Rookwood 51. Probably the most remarkable thing is the way the stories were selected at random, and in no form of chronological order. Maybe this was to try and disguise from the reader their true origin, and to make them appear as new as possible.

From an adult collector's point of view, some Greyfriars S.O.L.s leave a lot to be desired, and comparing them with the original Magnet stories in question, one can see that the editing at times could have been more carefully executed. On the other hand, whether readers at the time noticed this is highly unlikely.

Originally, in the Companion Papers Office, there was a Schoolboys Own Library stock-book indicating each issue, and source of stories. This, like four unpublished Greyfriars stories, was seemingly destroyed with other office files during W.W.II, but thanks to the research of two devoted Hamiltonians, John Shaw and Roger Jenkins, the origins of the Greyfriars S.O.L.s were traced some thirty years ago. Grateful thanks are due to them for their sterling work.

Like the Magnet, the Schoolboys' Own Library ceased publication without warning in 1940, due to the paper shortage, and readers were left stranded about two-thirds of the way through the 'Egyptian' series. It is interesting to note that a generation later, and in the very first of the Howard Baker reprints, the series to be published was The Egyptian series.
